TIMS 26.1.10

Summary

This patch release for TIMS 26.1 includes several bug fixes across Despatch, Charter, Workshop, and Rostering.

Bug Fixes and Improvements

Despatch – Plant arrival report not printing nodes if longer than 30 characters

If the Node Description was longer than 30 characters, no details would print on the Despatch Arrival Report. The report has been corrected and will now print node descriptions where the length exceeds 30 characters.

Despatch – Not syncing across different users/terminals

The day of operations screen was not displaying user actions or other users screens. The automatic refresh has been corrected so that changes will sync across terminals

Despatch - Sign on messages showing in late sign on screen

Drivers were incorrectly showing in the late sign on screen. The fix has refined the sign-on validation logic to correctly reference active shifts.

Driver Touch – Fault Types hidden in operations when hidden from driver touch

Fault types configured as unavailable in Driver Touch were also being hidden in the Operations/Despatch screen, even when they were flagged as available for Operations use. This meant operators could not select certain fault types (e.g. Accidents) when logging defects from the Operations screen. Fault types hidden from the Driver Touch screen are no longer incorrectly hidden from the Operations screen — each screen now respects its own visibility settings.

Workshop – Null values in FM Control Information causes a failure to import Pumpmate

When max usage values in the Fleet Manager Control Information are blank or have NULL values, the fuel loader fails to import data. These fields will now be treated as 0.00 values if they are blank or NULL.

Roster – Staff Roster (Weekly) report was splitting last roster line over pages

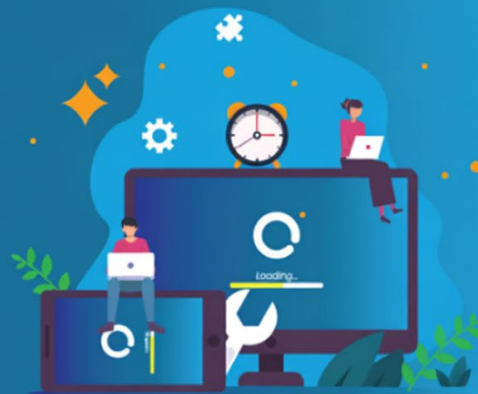
When option to print times and/or hours on the report is set to Y (Yes), the report was splitting the part of the bottom row on each page and printing this on the next page in the column headers. All roster times will be kept together rather than be split of pages.

Roster - Unable to Search Employees with Same Surname

Searching for employees by surname stopped returning multiple results — the search would only check the first matching employee and stop, making it impossible to find staff who share a surname. Employee surname searches now correctly return all matching staff, not just the first result found.

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TIMS Tablet – Defect depot was set from tablet depot not plant depot

TIMS Tablet settings include “Depot”. When a tablet is used to log a defect or to complete a pre-trip inspection (PTI) for a vehicle, the defect or PTI is assigned to the depot configured in tablet settings. TIMS Tablet defaults to using the plant depot for new defects and PTIs.

Workshop Stocktake App – Counts can uploaded multiple times on the same or additional tablets

When using the stocktake app, counts could be uploaded multiple times. The app did not display the quantity or indicate that an item has been counted. New logic introduced so that stocktake counts can no longer be uploaded more than once, preventing duplicate entries from appearing during the stocktake process.

Charter – Charter allocation depart/arrive time not saving

When a departure or arrival time was blank on the Charter Allocation screen, entering and saving a time appeared to work but the value was not actually saved — reloading the screen would show the field blank again. Times entered in Charter Allocation now save correctly and are no longer lost when the screen is reloaded.
