


TIMS 26.1 New Feature Highlights

TIMS 26.1 introduces a refreshed system look with a modern login and customisable icon themes, including the *Nouveau* option. Driver Terminal enhancements strengthen Fit for Work compliance, now integrating with Alcolizer breath test units. Operations gain smarter vehicle range calculations and improved handling of failed Sign Ons, while Payroll updates include Payday Superannuation changes.

System – Look and Feel

- A new logon screen has been created. This now appears in the centre of the screen.



- New TIMS icons are available as a theme. Change the icon theme in System Configuration. A new theme called *Nouveau* is available to change the look of the TIMS icons. Here's a peek at the new icons:



Driver Terminal

Fit for Work enhancements have been made in the Driver Terminal.

- Sign On questions can now prevent a driver from logging on if they answer 'No' to a Fit for Work question.
- Support for integration with Alcolizer breath test units has been added

Operations Screen

- Vehicle range calculations are now available in the Daily Operations Screen.
- Overriding a Fit for Work failed Sign On requires the entry of a Reason.

- Warnings are displayed if a vehicle allocation exceeds its calculated remaining range.
- Note that for existing Operations data Timesheets will need to be regenerated to display distance and time values.
- Note that for correct distance and time values to be displayed new schedule loads will be required.

Payroll

- Payday Superannuation changes, as required for reporting from 1 July 2026, are now available in TIMS Payroll.
- A “qualified earnings” flag is available for Pay Types. Payroll clients should ensure the flag is set appropriately for all relevant Pay Types. No significant changes to payroll processes are expected, aside from the once off setup to tick this new flag accordingly.

TIMS 26.1 Enhancements to Existing Features

Enhancements or improvements have been made in the below areas in TIMS.

Operations Screen

- New driver Sign On icons have been created to align with the Driver Terminal Fit for Work functionality. The icons displayed are:

Sign-on Icons

- | | |

- Additional flyout details - now show **sign on/off times**, licencing information, and shift details.
- Double left click on an Employee, a Despatch, or any open work to display the Shift Sheet.
- Shift Sheets have been redesigned to improve readability.
- It is now possible to delete non-schedule lines from the Shift Sheet
- Arrive dates for Shift Sheet lines can now be changed. Double left click to edit.
- Legends are now available as a **right click** option in specific Operations screen columns (Employee, Despatch, Relief, Bus). They provide a quick reference for colour codes and icons, helping users interpret statuses such as sign on, fatigue breaches, and vehicle allocation overlaps.

Roster

- When generating Timesheets a warning is displayed if previously generated Timesheets have been locked.

Web Driver Roster

- Shifts with the same Day Type will now display on a single line.

Assets

- Import Assets Template has been updated to include the Fair Value Fields. Please contact Trapeze Support for a copy of the new Asset Additions Template.

Fleet Manager

- Table logging has been added to the Permit table to track changes to permits if required. Contact Trapeze Support to organise data retrieval.

Web Driver Terminal

- Full functional parity with Driver Touch Application including:
 - Defect functionality
 - Printing of Driver Worksheets

Crystal Reports

- All Crystal Reports identified as requiring conversion have been converted to Jasper Reports.
- Crystal Reports will be removed fully from TIMS as of 26.2 onwards.

TIMS 26.1 System Tweaks and Fixes

System

- Miscellaneous User Interface tweaks and polish.

Roster

- Fixed an issue where incorrect Shifts were being used when generating a Roster using Replace.
- Fixed an issue with the display of Leave when the Driver belongs to a different Business Unit.
- Fixed an issue with using incorrect Department Code for employees in the Roster causing an error.
- Fixed an issue with the Scratchpad loading too many Shifts when checking for missing Shifts.
- Fixed an issue with incorrect Fatigue breaches being displayed when a Roster is regenerated using a different Duty Template.

Day of Operations

- Realtime updates to the Yard Plan screen have been improved.
- Standby type shifts are now correctly generated in Operations.

Creditors

- Fixed an issue where the Department was not being displayed when opening a transaction.
- Fixed an issue with Creditor transactions being coded to an incorrect department.

Bank Reconciliation

- Fixed an issue where an error would occur when dragging an item to unapply.

Inventory

- Fixed an issue where Items remain in the Suggested Re-orders list when they have been ordered but subsequently cancelled.
- Fixed an issue with duplicate Stocktake lines being displayed if item is present in multiple Warehouses in the same location.

Workshop Touch

- Fixed a problem where work orders were not created properly if the fault notes exceeded approx. 480 characters.

Payroll

- Fixed an issue with ABN numbers not displaying when opening an Employee record.

TIMS Tablet

- Fixed an issue with the TIMS Tablet App whereby users could get 'stuck' in a loop after logging a defect and attempting to perform a PTI on the replacement bus.
- Illegal characters are ignored when doing searches.
