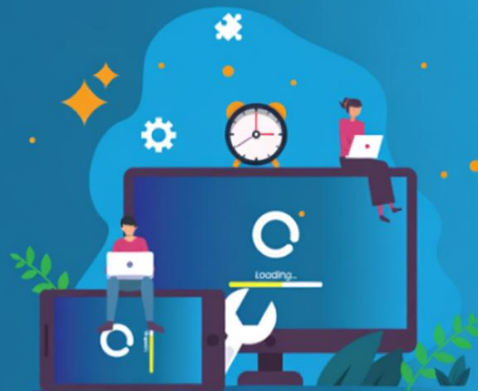

TIMS 26.2.4 – 27 July 2026

Summary

This is a bug-fix patch for TIMS 26.2.4. It resolves issues across Despatch, Payroll and Charter, and adds an enhancement to the Scratchpad that protects roster work from being overwritten when several users save at the same time.

Bug Fixes & Improvements

Despatch – Editing shift sheets for open work no longer causes an error

When editing a shift sheet for an unallocated entry in the Open Work area, the system could report an error while updating sign-on times, interrupting the user. Shift sheet changes for open work now save reliably without error.

Despatch – Driver suggestions no longer allocate conflicting work

When Driver Decision Support suggestions were used repeatedly to allocate open and charter work, the top suggested driver could be inconsistent and occasionally led to work being allocated that clashed with an existing allocation. The suggestions are now reliable and no longer allocate conflicting work.

Despatch – Driver suggestion results display correctly on slower connections

On slower connections, the text in the Driver Decision Support result cells could briefly turn white or disappear while results were loading, making them hard to read. The display now stays in step as results load, so the information remains readable throughout.

Despatch – Yard Plan slot selection now lines up with the mouse

In Yard Plan Setup the highlighted slot did not line up with the mouse pointer — it sat several slots higher — which made it easy to pick the wrong slot. The pointer and the selected slot now match, so slots can be selected accurately.

Payroll – Payroll now cleared correctly for employees with no roster

When payroll was calculated for a business unit, standard pay records were not always removed for employees who had no rostered work in the period, which could leave incorrect pay entries against those employees. The process now correctly clears these records so pay reflects only employees who were rostered.

Payroll – Leave balances now display correctly

Some employees' Leave Balances showed no information even though leave had accrued, because the leave accrual process was not running correctly and did not create the expected records. The accrual process now runs as intended, so leave balances populate and display correctly.

Charter – Group name restored in Receivings notes

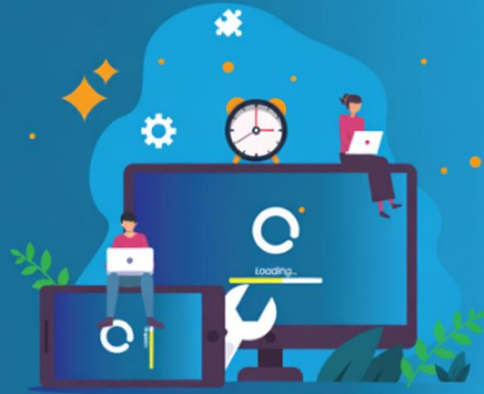
When entering Receivings for a purchase order involving multiple ships, the group name no longer appeared in the Notes section, making it difficult to tell which line to mark as received. The group name is now shown again in the Notes, so the correct line can be identified without cross-checking the Charter Calendar.

New Features & Enhancements

Roster – Scratchpad protection against overwriting other users' changes

Previously, when several users had the Scratchpad open on different roster periods and saved at the same time, they could overwrite one another's work, causing duplicate entries and roster save failures. The Scratchpad now saves only the periods you have changed. This prevents users from overwriting periods they have not touched.
